- Provide hands-on investigations of ecological science concepts
- Immerse campers in fun activities that teach about New York State's fish, wildlife, and native plants
- Promote participation in outdoor activities—canoeing, hiking, camping, fishing and more—led by highly qualified staff
- Offer optional sportsman education programs, taught by certified instructors
- Are affordable: \$350 per camper for each one-week session

Camp Information:

- Seven week-long sessions during July and August.
- Youth Camp sessions serve campers 11 to 13 years old. (Campers who are 10 years old may register for Youth Camp if they will be 11 by December 1 of that year.)
- Teen Ecology Camp sessions serve campers 14 to 17 years old and offer a more advanced program. (Campers who are 13 years old may register for Teen Ecology Camp if they will be 14 by December of that year.)
- *Camper check-in is 3:00 PM Sunday*
Camper check-out/pick up is 4:30 PM Friday.
- Campers may register for multiple sessions for which they are eligible.
